

NORTHWOOD UNIVERSITY ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD CRITERIA:

Selection for Scholarship awards shall be based on academic merit and financial need. Each recipient must be a United States citizen and must be enrolled at the University full-time for the upcoming academic year. Additional criteria are as follows:

- (a) Female, Minimum of junior status
- (b) Minimum of junior status
- (c) Majoring in Automotive Marketing
- (d) Carrying a minimum of a 3.0 G.P.A.
- (e) Involved in extracurricular activities

If, however, students meeting the above criteria are not found, Northwood may award Scholarship funds to otherwise qualified students.

SELECTION:

The number of students selected to receive an award of Scholarship funds will be based on the criteria set forth in Section above (each, a "Scholarship Recipient") and according to how much is available for awarding. Each Scholarship Recipient shall receive an award for one academic year for the purpose of providing financial support for the Scholarship Recipient's study. The final selection of the Scholarship Recipients shall be made by the University Scholarship Committee (the "Scholarship Committee") in accordance with the University's and Scholarship Committee's policies and practices, and, in turn, the Scholarship Committee shall notify the Donor of the Scholarship Recipient(s). The University shall also supply public relations materials in accordance with Northwood's public relations policy on Scholarship Recipient(s).

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION PROCESS:

To be considered as an eligible candidate for this scholarship, applicants are required to have "opted-in" to the Private Donor Scholarship (PDS) program with Northwood University. Information about the Scholarship shall be made available by the University Scholarship Office by December 1 of the year prior to disbursement. All students applying for a scholarship award must be accepted and committed students for the year in which they are applying and have obtained a minimum grade point of 3.0 cumulative.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RETENTION:

In addition to maintaining the selection criteria indicated in Section 2 above, each Scholarship Recipient is required to:

- (a) Be a student in "Good Standing"

CONDUCT:

Each Scholarship Recipient must conform to all rules, regulations and disciplinary measures of the University, both as to conduct and class standing. The University reserves the right to cancel the Scholarship award and dismiss from the University any student, including a Scholarship Recipient, who has violated the rules and regulations of the University or who has failed to meet the University's requirements, in the University's sole discretion.
